



JUNIOR SECONDARY SCHOLARSHIPS 2018

The Parents' and Citizens' Association of Mackay North State High School is very pleased to be offering six scholarships for students who commence Year 7 in 2018.

The six scholarships will be awarded for:

- (a) academic excellence or
- (b) sporting excellence or
- (c) cultural excellence

Criteria:

Applicants must currently be enrolled in Year 6 at a primary school in the Mackay district and be recommended by their primary school for these scholarships. Scholarships will run for a maximum of three years. Students awarded a Junior Secondary Scholarship will be monitored at the end of Year 7 and again at the end of Year 8 to ensure they abide by the school's disciplinary code and maintain a record of excellence and participation in the field for which they were awarded their scholarship.

Guidelines:

Scholarship applications will be processed by a panel at Mackay North State High School and the recipients will be notified by early October. Recipients will be presented with their scholarships at a special ceremony at Mackay North State High School on 18th October 2017. The decision of the panel will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. Late applications will not be considered.

Applications must be received by Mackay North State High School by 25th August 2017 to be considered.

A Mackay North State High School scholarship will entitle the student to the following:

- (a) A one off \$200 contribution to assist with each recipient's education costs is made by the P&C for the Year 7 (2017) students.
- (b) Waived fees for the school's Student Resource Scheme in Years 7, 8 and 9
- (c) Waived curriculum field excursions costs in the Mackay area in Years 7, 8 and 9
- (d) Waived fees into national academic competitions in Years 7, 8 and 9
- (e) Waived fees for Mackay and District Sport Representation in Years 7, 8 and 9
- (f) Waived fees for Mackay North SHS Instrumental Music Program Years 7, 8 and 9

Additional Information:

- Applicants may apply in one or more areas of excellence and will be considered separately for each category.
- All applications will be kept confidential.
- If an awardee does not take up the scholarship offer, the panel can reconsider the next recommended applicant.
